PLEASE READ THESE NOTES CAREFULLY

Members are required to play on all 4 days.

Golf Carts— R **240.** An adequate number of carts should be available but priority will be given to those players who need a cart for **medical reasons** for all 4 days. Privately owned carts are not permitted.

There is a limited amount of space for storage and charging facilities available at the course, so please advise your Secretary if these facilities are required.

Caddie fees will be R 250 plus tip per round at both courses.

Players needing similar tee off times in order to travel together – please ensure your request is included on your application.

The Draw will endeavour to accommodate your request (maximum group size of 4) but this may not be possible on Thursday and Friday, due to varied handicaps in the Championships.

Seniors and their ladies are strongly encouraged to attend both the opening Cocktail Party and the closing Gala Dinner.

The formal dress requirement for the Gala Dinner is a dark suit or blazer, dark trousers and Senior's tie or bow tie.

Should there be changes to the information you have put on your entry application please inform your **Secretary.**

This is important for the Draw if your handicap moves into or out of the Championship division.

The Ladies programme is subject to change depending on demand for the various events. Changes will be updated on the website and highlighted at registration. All tours, for which transport is provided, depart from the golf club.

Where own transport is required, maps to venues will be provided in the welcome bag.

If you require accommodation in the Johannesburg area, visit the website or contact the Gauteng secretary for additional details of B&Bs, guest houses and hotels.

Refunds for cancellations of accepted entries:

For cancellations advised to the Tournament Director before the 15th of March – a full refund will be paid.

Refunds after the 15th of March will only be granted due to major illness, death and other exceptional circumstances.

Where the Gauteng Society has had to pay a deposit for tours or functions, no refund will be made.
