The East London Golf Club, founded on 20 April 1893, opened with a 12 hole course on 6th July 1893. Now on its third site, procured in 1923, it has consistently ranked among the top 20 courses in the country.

The West Bank Golf Club dates from 1907, initially as a 9 hole shale greens course, evolving in 1929 to the 18 hole grass green course of today. It has unique features of a lighthouse (the Club's emblem) and a cemetery, the natural defence however, being the wind.
